Begin a persistence effort to repair and rebuild.*

Lust



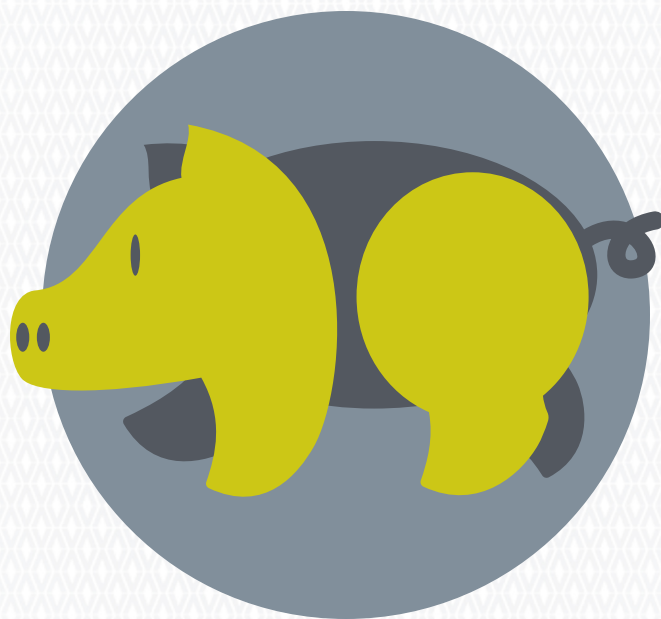
Lust for money or power.
